#### A BIT ABOUT US


The Canalside Heritage Centre is focused on the history of Beeston Lock and the Nottingham and Beeston Canal and tells an important story about trade, travel, industrialisation, and homes of the past. The Weir Cottages are the home to our Heritage Centre, which we have worked hard to transform into a lively hub of community activity. Originally, there were four cottages (later converted into one house), which were inhabited from the mid-eighteenth century.

These cottages have been home to artists, gamekeepers, servants, coal miners, carpenters, blacksmiths and much more. The cottages were last inhabited in 1996 before falling into disuse. Today, after a Heritage Lottery funded renovation project, the site brings you stories about the Beeston Rylands' canalside community and invites visitors to share in the heritage of the Weir Cottages. We have an activity room where we hold community and learning sessions, a tearoom, community gardens, on-site apiary, and exhibition space.

### **OPENING TIMES**

We welcome visitors to the centre 7 days a week from **9.30am to 4.30pm.** Please note that some of our events and activities do take place outside of our normal opening hours.
